Learning outcomes, assessment methods and assessment criteria

Learning Outcome 1

Demonstrate a broad understanding of a social model of health and the causes of health inequalities

Assessment Methods

Part 2 Assignment: Please refer to Appendix 4 of the Tutor Guidelines for detailed requirements

Assessment Description

In the Assignment the student should identify statistical or research evidence of health inequalities.

Assessment criteria

The Assignment should include statistical or other evidence of the health issue that they are dealing with in their assignment and how that issue relates to other factors that impact on health.

Learning Outcome 2

Develop a broad understanding of a community development approach to health and the key concepts and principles that inform this approach

Assessment Methods

Written Learning Log Units 11 and 12: Although the Pack requests a minimum of 6 Learning Logs: 5 will be acceptable Part 2 Assignment

Assessment Description

The learning logs should reference the individual and structural explanations of health and how a community development approach could be used to tackle health issues. They should also identify key concepts around participation and citizenship and how these relate to the National Standards for Community Engagement

The assignment should identify a community health issue and clearly show how it could be tackled through a community development approach

Assessment Criteria

The learning logs must include references to individual and structural explanations of health and how community development approaches have been used to tackle health inequalities.

The assignment must include an exposition of what a community development approach would be and how it could be used in practice to tackle an identified health inequality

Learning Outcome 3

Demonstrate a broad understanding of community research methods

Assessment Method

Written Learning Log Unit 10

Part 2 Assignment

Assessment Description

The learning log should reference research methods.

The assignment should identify research methods used during the research phase.

Assessment Criteria

The learning logs must include a description of at least 2 research methods used and put forward a view on what the student thinks of them in terms of usefulness.

The assignment must give a description of the research methods used and the reason for choosing them. The student should demonstrate they have analysed the data and what evidence this provides for them of a health issue

Learning Outcome 4

Use a range of community research methods in project work and use a wide range of skills in presenting the outcomes of this work to their peers

Assessment Method

Observed participation in planning, researching, analysing and presenting evidence from their research.

Assessment Description

Tutor Report Form: The tutor will observe and record the students contribution to the development of a research question and Plan and their contribution to carrying out the research

Assessment Criteria

The student must contribute to the planning, development and carrying out the research

Learning Outcome 5

Work under their own initiative and as part of a team in carrying out project work

Assessment Methods

Observed participation in and contribution to the group project

Assessment Description

The tutor will observe and record the students participation in the community research project

Assessment Criteria

The student must participate in all 3 stages of the community research project

Learning Outcome 6

Reflect on their own learning and practice throughout the programme

Assessment Methods

Leaning Logs 9,10,11,12,13 and 14

Assessment Description

In the Learning Logs the learner will reflect on their contribution to, and their learning from each Unit

Assessment Criteria

Students will complete a minimum of 5 learning logs. We know the Pack says 6 but that's a mistake.
